Since the first seminar held in Philadelphia, the group has met every year in locations in the U.S.A., Canada, and The United Kingdom. Meeting venues have included San Francisco, Boston, Williamsburg, Dallas, Pasadena, Pittsburgh, Long Beach, Toronto, Canada, as well as London, and Staffordshire, England.

### Who Are We?

Members include individual collectors, ceramic and art historians, prominent ceramics dealers, as well as museum professionals. The objective of the seminar is to provide those in attendance with insight into the history, techniques, and wares of the Wedgwood company over its three centuries, as well as an opportunity to network.

There are several local collectors' groups that offer their members the opportunity to meet locally and discuss Wedgwood. The WIS is the only international association that brings people together from all over the world.
